

Painting for Illusion | 1 day (all levels)

No painting experience necessary - No sewing machine

Don't have the right fabric? Pieces not blending together well? Need a detail, a shadow, a highlight? Embellish and enhance your quilt top with paint. Learn simple techniques that will bring 3-D life to your quilt image. In the first half of this class you'll put together a small fused quilt of a still life and in the second half use it as your canvas to apply textile paints.

Supply list for Painting for Illusion:

Tools:

Small rotary cutter and sharp blade, cutting mat, iron and board, ballpoint pen, black sharpie marker, straight pins, xacto knife, apron, paper sandwich bag, Scotch magic tape.

Fabrics:

15 x 20" piece of black background fabric as a foundation piece.

Kit \$35: Half yard of hand dye which will complete project, original pattern, freezer paper, parchment paper, Misty White fuse, Transdoodle transfer paper, textile paint, brushes, and paper goods.

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
